Dr. McFee received a Master's of Theological Studies degree at Saint Paul School of Theology with a concentration in Preaching and Worship, where she recently received the Outstanding Graduate Award from the Alumni Association. She has a Ph.D. in liturgical studies from the Graduate Theological Union and has been an adjunct and guest lecturer at 10 seminaries.
