Funding For Your Camp Adventure!

We believe camp is an important experience that no one should miss. Money is available to help those who cannot afford to go to camp. There are four different sources of financial help, including:

Local Church: Many of our local United Methodist churches offer "camperships." Some pay the full cost, others may offer half the cost or a flat amount. Contact your pastor or Camping Steward to find out if your church offers assistance.

Conference level: The Western PA Conference of the UMC offers help for campers who qualify for the free or reduced price school lunch program and for families sending more than one child to camp (Family camp events are excluded as the cost is already discounted.) The mail-in application is available online at wpaumc.org/camping. Make sure your pastor signs the form! Send your completed form to the Conference office at PO Box 5002, 1204 Freedom Road, Cranberry Twp., PA 16066-0002 when you register for camp.

Camp level: Each of the three camps have campership funds available for campers attending its events. Contact the camp you will attend for information about financial aid.

Bring a friend: A \$10 recruiter credit is given for each new camper you recruit. A "new" camper is someone who has never attended a Western PA Camping and Retreat Ministry summer camping event. There is no limit to the number of new camper recruiter credits you can get. To receive credit for your efforts, just fill out the "recruiter form" that is available online or by calling the camping office at 800.886.3382 ext. 232.

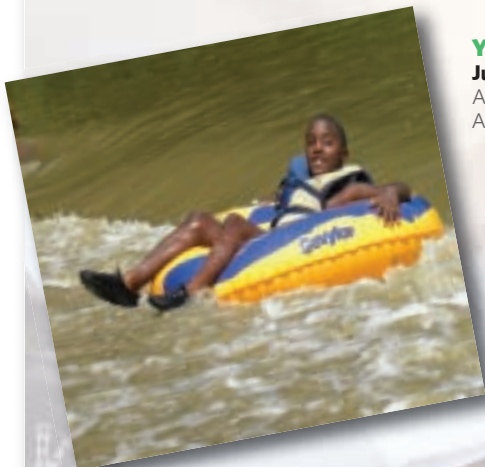

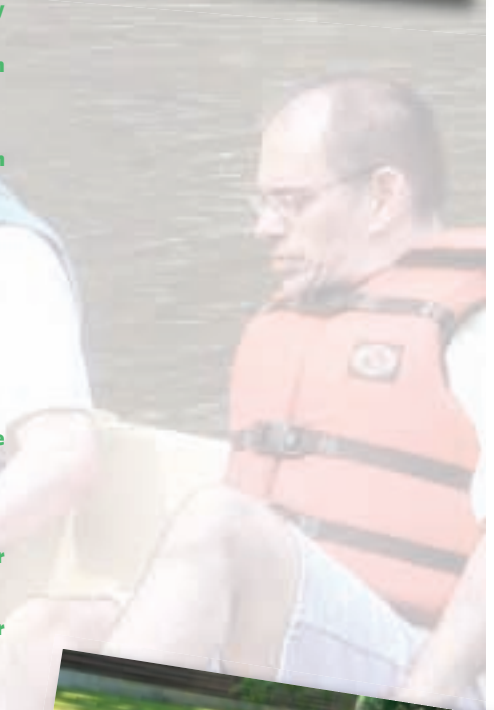

Counselor in Training

C.I.T. features a Spring Training weekend at each camp and a supervised week with campers!

Camp-counselor basics start this two-part Counselor in Training (CIT) program. CIT is a program for 15 - 17 year olds to learn how to be and practice being a camp counselor.

Part One This is the first part of the CIT training program. The weekend begins with registration at 7 pm on Friday evening and concludes on Sunday at 1 pm. This is a very intense time focusing on learning counselor skills as well as accepting new challenges in your faith journey. Once you have finished this process, you may be invited to serve as a CIT for one additional week during the summer of 2012. This must be coordinated through your CIT Dean or site representative.

We are grateful to local church people for giving mission dollars through their churches to the Annual Conference Connectional Apportionments. These funds help pay the Summer Program Staff. Also, many individuals make second-mile special gifts to the camps through the Advance Specials. These gifts make it possible to reduce the price of the Counselor In Training events, increase training opportunities for volunteers and improve the stipend for Summer Program Staff. Refund Policy

If a registered camper will be unable to attend camp, notify the camping office immediately in order to get any refund. Refunds are given up to two weeks before the start of camp, minus the \$50 non-refundable deposit. In case of cancellation during the last two weeks before the event, only the room and board portion of the fee will be refunded for illness or an accident. The Camping Office must be notified immediately of any accident or illness followed within one week by a written request for the room and board refund. You must include a doctor's written explanation about what accident or illness keeps the camper from camp. Since many events have waiting lists, your timely attention is appreciated.

No refunds will be made after the start of camp.
