We want to wish each of you a very Merry Christmas and express our sincere appreciation for the time, talent and money you have donated to St. Paul's Volunteers in Mission this past year. The contributions that each of you make enable our group to continue to help people who are less fortunate than we.

This year, twenty-six different people spent 885 volunteer hours on four local projects and the work camp in Eastern PA. Nine of these people were first time volunteers with VIM. Our Palm Sunday Pancake Breakfast had a profit of about \$720 and we made about \$165 serving lunch at the Mission Mall. Several people, either members of VIM or church members, donated money, materials or tools for our work. We spent over \$760 on materials for local projects for which we received no reimbursement. We received \$2,000 from the Conaway-Munden fund which we donated to the Susquehanna UM Conference for flood relief materials while working in Eastern PA. We continue to receive jobs and some financial support from North Hills Community Outreach.

As we look to the future we expect to be working in New Jersey in the spring. We hope to encourage younger people to join us in our mission.
