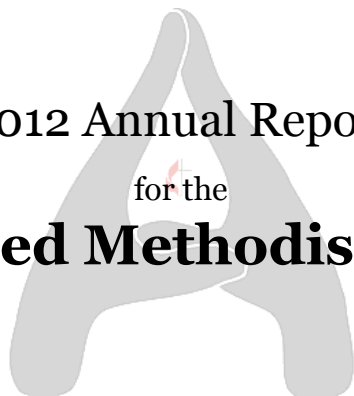

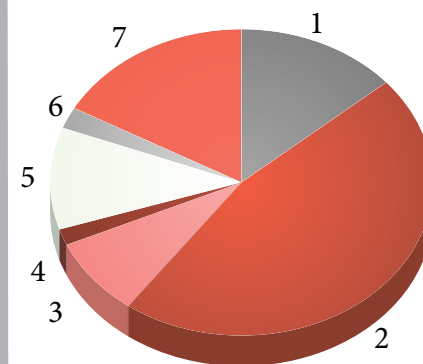
**OUR MISSION** at EUMA is to provide those who are homeless and in need with safe shelter, basic necessities and life skills training as they work toward their greatest potential.

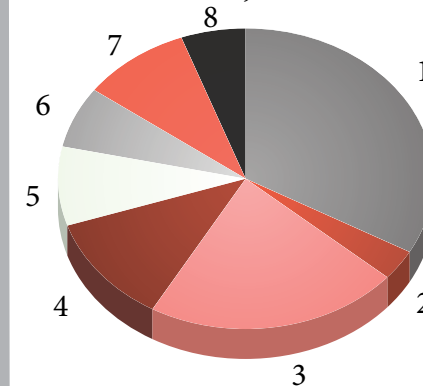

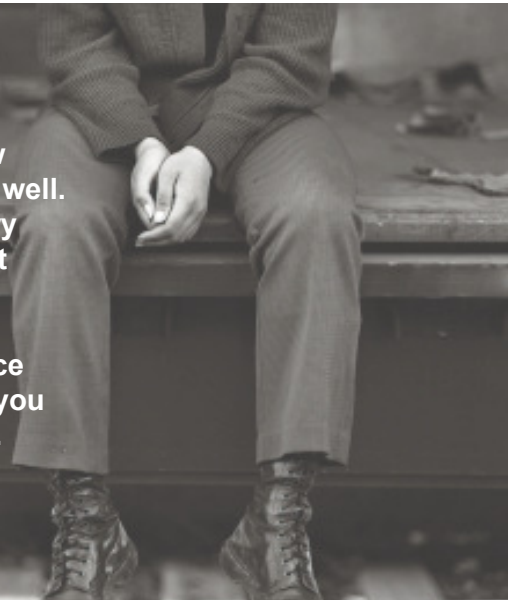

**Hope House**, a four-unit apartment complex providing transitional shelter and programming to homeless families with children.

**Liberty House**, a 10-bed transitional shelter and program for homeless Veteran men.

**Project Hope Outreach**, on-the-street ministry to the homeless community offering assistance, referrals, basic necessities and support.

**The Rainbow Connection**, a thrift store providing financial support to EUMA programs and offering free clothing and household items to homeless individuals and those in need.
